**Biografija F. Indeo:** Dr. Fabio Indeo is a Visiting Research Associate at the Center for Energy Governance and Security (EGS) at the Hanyang University in Seoul, South Korea. He is also an External Researcher at the University of Camerino (Italy), contributor to the Eurasian Business Dispatch and External Fellow Collaborator with the Geopolitical Studies Research Center (Prague). Occasionally, Fabio Indeo is also a lecturer on energy security in the Middle East and North Africa with the NATO Regional Cooperation Course at the NATO Defense College in Rome.

As an expert in geopolitics, Dr. Indeo earned his PhD from the University of Trieste, where his research focused on the strategic relationship between the European Union and Central Asia. He is the author of several publications on geopolitical and energy issues, among which include: *The Southern Gas Corridor's Adriatic Dimension: Slovenia, Croatia and Montenegro*, *Azerbaijan and the New Energy Geopolitics of the Southeastern Europe* and *Energy Security in North East Asia: The Vulnerability of Maritime Energy Routes and Strategies of Diversification*.
